

Competition Rules

- Females and males between the ages of 4 - 30 can enter.
- The entry age of an entrant shall be the age he/she is on the day that the entry form and proof of payment is received by the Organizers.
- Proof of age must be made available to the Organizers if so requested. Failure in making the said documentation available timeously may lead to the immediate disqualification of the entrant.
- Interference whatever the nature shall not be tolerated and could lead to the disqualification of the entrant on whose behalf has been intervened. The decisions of the judges are final and no correspondence shall be entered into.
- The Organizers reserve the right to take any verifying measurement from any entrant during any stage of the competition. Refusal by any entrant could lead to immediate disqualification.
- All entrants must realize that the entry fee does not cover any expenses relating to meals, accommodation and travelling during the three day Grand Finale Event.
- The Organizers shall not accept any liability for damages suffered by any person involved with the competition should any sponsor withdraw or amend their sponsorship. The entrant hereby indemnifies the Organizers' should any claim arise whatsoever.
- The Organizers also reserve the right to make changes to the entry process and to the schedule envisaged for the Grand Finale if it is deemed necessary to do so without the prior notification, permission and consent from any entrant, finalists, parent, sponsor and any person or entity directly or indirectly involved or effected by such a change.
- MHI has the right to change the terms, conditions and dates of this event, as they see fit.
- Prizes received are not redeemable for cash or transferable and shall strictly be awarded in accordance with the sponsor's specific requests.
- No entrant, finalist or winner may issue a press release pertaining to the competition without the written consent of the Organizers or affording last-mentioned an opportunity to reply in writing to the statement before it's intended release.
- Terms and Conditions of the contract apply to the contract winners, for example, models cannot change their weight or look without permission from the Agency etc. Since the Agency will have costs to develop the winner/s, to get them "market ready", a contract will have to be signed by the model with the Agency.

Entry Process

- up to four **R250,000 International Modelling Contracts** to be won by up to four models at the Final Event.
- Model Hunt & Model Hunt International 2010/11 (MHI) competition is scouting for the local and international market, and is divided into two stages namely a first round casting judging session from photos and then a FINAL GALA EVENT over 3 days. Successful contenders from the first round will be invited to the FINAL GALA EVENT.
- Entrants between the ages of 4 and 30 years can enter, and no prior modelling experience is necessary. They shall compete within four (4) age groups for females namely 4 to 8yrs, 9 to 12yrs, 13 to 16yrs and 17 to 30 yrs and (3) age groups for males namely 4 to 11yrs, 12 to 16yrs and 17 to 30yrs.
- Entrants need not be from South Africa, belong to a modelling school or Agency to enter.
- Entrants shall pay an initial first round entry fee of **R200-00 per person** to enter the MODEL HUNT INTERNATIONAL competition.
- All entry fees must be paid into the following bank account – Standard Bank, Acc Type: Cheque, Acc Name: Model Hunt International, Acc Number: 201 123 967, Branch Code: Midrand 00 11 55.
- Entrants can enter the competition via the Internet, E-mail, through the post, at different venues and associated events, attending an official casting session or invited to do so by an accredited scout.
- If an entrant wishes to enter via the Internet (online), or for more info, he/she will have to visit our official website - www.ModelHuntInternational.co.uk (venues, dates and times where scouts will be, will be updated all the time on the web) - and/or complete the online entry form. After supplying the information, which will include uploading three (3) full colour photographs (head & shoulder, full length, body). The entrant will then be required to submit said entry form. If you do not have internet, feel free to contact our offices at 0724474855
- Once the entrant has paid the entry fee he/she will forward a copy of the proof of payment to our office using the competition number as his/her terms of reference. Fax nr 086 657 9530
- If an entrant wishes to enter via E-mail or post he/she will have to go online to download a copy of the Model Hunt International entry form or contact our offices at 072 447 4855 (9h00 – 17h00) to request a copy of said entry form. Said entry form will then be e-mailed to the entrant.
- A completed entry form, three full colour photographs or Z-card, together with the proof of entry fee payment must then be forwarded to the Organisers should the entrant enter via the post or E-mail
- Entry photographs that are either posted via E-mail or the internet must be in a jpeg format and not exceed 1MB in size.
- If an entrant enters via the post then he/she must please put the entry form, photographs on CD/DVD and proof of payment together in one (1) envelope and post it per registered post to: Model Hunt, P.O. Box 7831, Halfway House, Midrand, 1685. Should it get lost for some or other reason we shall then at least have a tracking number to find it.
- If an entrant enters via E-mail he/she must attach the completed entry form, proof of payment and three (3) full colour photographs in one bundle and forward it to – info@ModelHuntinternational.co.uk All attachments must either be in a word document or jpeg or pdf formats.
- All entries received via the internet, post or email will be judged in camera on an ad-hoc basis. Once judged we shall inform entrants if they have made it through to the GALA FINAL as finalist.
- Successful entrants shall then be provided with an "information kit" pertaining to the Grand Finale.

- Postal entries for Model Hunt International 2010/11 will close on the 18th November 2011.
- Online Entries (either through e-mail or on website) will close on the 1st December 2011.

The Grand Finale 2011

- The MODEL HUNT INTERNATIONAL (MHI) Grand Finale shall be hosted in Gauteng, South Africa over a 3 day period from the **9th to 11th December 2011** (first weekend of the school holidays) – venue will be confirmed and all information will be in the finalist letter (information tool kit)
- All finalists who attend the MHI Finals are welcome to bring with their Portfolios (with a minimum of 10 photos) to the final , it will then be given to the judges/scouts to take into consideration for awarding the one or more international contracts.
- Models who do not have a Portfolio are welcome to arrange a shoot with Pro Image: 083 753 7223. For an example of their work go to www.theProImage.co.za

- All finalists need only to pay the once off Finals Registration Fee (not the first round fee) and shall not be required to pay any further fees to attend the three day Grand Finale and will therefore be granted free access to all the days
- The Final Registration fee however, does not cover the finalists travelling, accommodation and meal expenses for the Grand Finale. Sponsorship forms are available for models that need to raise funds.
- **For each specific days details and schedule please refer to the finalist letter (which will be sent to each invited finalist)**
- The attending finalists will all be judged, in 6 Model Cup divisions namely – Photographic, Ramp, Body, Pageant, Freeze & Beat. All finalist's points scored in the different divisions will automatically count towards their individual age and division categories for every model's National Colours Rankings in Model Cup (for no extra fee), which will also be awarded at the final event. For more info on how the Provincial and National colours work, go to www.modelcup.co.za . Also see how you can compete to share in up to R50 000-00 cash at the end of the Model Cup year.
- The judging panel on all 3 days will be industry related people (reflecting the fashion industry - photographers, designers, make-up artists, stylists and hairdressers, agencies and scouts).
- For dress code also refer to the finalist letter.
- Judges and scouts that want to draw up call-back lists after judging sessions, should they wish to, may make contact with any of the finalists after the Gala Event & Awards.
- The call-back lists of the judges, agents, agencies and scouts will be put up on the notice boards at the venue immediately after the Award Ceremony on day 3.
- These callback lists have got nothing to do with the judging process and in no way reflect or affect the overall judging results. The call-back lists are only an indication of who the specific agent, agency or scout might like and would like to see.
- It is also important to note that the decision of the International Contract winner/s is solely at the official scout's discretion, the judging points doesn't have a say here. So the International Modelling Contract(s) is in no way guided by the judging panel when it comes to selecting the up to 4 R250.000 International Modelling contract winner/s. The contract winner(s) will be the overall winners of their overall category of Model Hunt International, and then the judges points will kick in to determine 2nd/3rd/4th and on places.

- Automatic points on the board to qualify for your Model Cup National Colours 2012 in 6 divisions with according to your performance in the MHI Final, (to the value of R350), the model would then only compete in their own age group for their national colours.
